



FACT SHEET

One of Bermuda's finest resort properties, The Reefs has been welcoming guests since 1947 with the traditional hospitality for which the island has long been famous. Crowning a cliff and overlooking its own private pink sand beach and the turquoise waters that surround Bermuda, The Reefs is in the Southampton parish on the South Shore of the island. Lush tropical flowers – hibiscus, oleander and bougainvillea – cascade down the salmon pink-and-white property. An intimate resort with only 64 guest rooms and suites (including seven Cottages with outdoor Jacuzzis), the resort boasts an infinity pool, and an award-winning spa. The atmosphere is relaxing and one of the resort's most notable features – and a reason guests return year after year – is its dedicated staff. Several staff members have been with The Reefs for more than 20 years. The Reefs is justly famous for its cuisine and its restaurants attract visitors and Bermudians alike. It is the island's only small resort with three dining venues during the season. Couples can also opt for a romantic dinner served on the beach.

The Reefs has consistently been voted one of the "Best Hotels in the Caribbean, Bahamas and Bermuda" – ranked # 1 "World's Best Hotel Value" for three consecutive years – by the readers of *Travel + Leisure* and has been on *Condé Nast Traveler's Gold List* of the "World's Best Places to Stay" since 1997. Accommodations

- 45 guest rooms (poolside (7), superior (9), deluxe (17) and premier (12) categories) with private balconies and ocean views

All accommodations are air-conditioned and have ceiling fans; amenities include: mini refrigerator; hairdryer; coffee maker; TV and DVD player; dataport; in-room safe; iron and board; bathrobes; umbrella; and Taylor of London toiletries

- Three (3) Point Suites (680 sq. ft.) feature luxurious bathrooms with large Jacuzzis; separate rainwater showers; double sinks; and step-down sitting areas facing private ocean-view balconies with outdoor Jacuzzis
- Eight (8) Junior Suites have step-down sitting areas facing private ocean-view balconies, luxurious bathrooms with soaking tubs and walk-in rainwater showers
- One (1) Longtail Suite has a separate sitting room, an ocean-view balcony, and a luxurious bathroom with Jacuzzi

All suites feature king-size beds; ceiling fans; flat-screen television with cable; VCR and DVD player; dataport; hairdryer; and bathrobes

- Seven (7) one- to four-bedroom ocean-view cottages located in the gardens of The Reefs

All cottage suites are air-conditioned, have ceiling fans and are fully equipped with dataport; free long-distance access; cable TV; VCR and DVD player; hairdryers; bathrobes; toaster; microwave; and private patios with outdoor Jacuzzis. In-room refrigerators are stocked with guests' preferences on advance request.

Dining

The Reefs is Bermuda's only small hotel with three dining options during the season.

- **Grill 56**

Traditional Bermudian architecture with limestone walls and exposed beams gives Grill 56, The Reefs' main dining room, a welcoming ambiance. Grill 56 serves breakfast (8:15 AM to 10:00 AM), lunch (Noon to 3:00 PM) and dinner (6:30 PM to 8:45 PM). Four-course dinner menu offers contemporary cuisine with Mediterranean, Caribbean and Pacific Rim flavors. Bermudian dishes are also highlighted. Early dining (6:30 PM) for families with children. Dress is "smart casual." A popular brunch is offered on Sundays.

- **Coconuts Beach Bar and Restaurant**

Down by the beach and overlooking the ocean, the acclaimed Coconuts is cited as "best place to fall in love in Bermuda." Featuring Caribbean dishes with Bermudian accents, Coconuts is open for lunch from April to November (Noon to 3:00 PM), Snack bar (3:00 PM – 4:00 PM) and dinner from May to November (7:00 PM to 10:00 PM).

- **Ocean Echo Terrace**

Located on the terrace with a panoramic 180° ocean view, the Ocean Echo Terrace offers the same menu as Grill 56. Ocean Echo offers al fresco dining from May through October from 6:30 PM to 9:00 PM with a three- or four-course set menu.

- **The Lounge**

Complimentary afternoon tea is served daily from 4:00 PM to 5:00 PM.

- **The Conservatory**

The perfect spot for special occasions, small meetings or family gatherings, the Conservatory features year-round dining under the stars (and its glass ceiling) in a lush tropical setting.

- **Carousel Dining Program**

As a member of the Bermuda Collection, The Reefs will arrange for guests to dine at the other properties: Cambridge Beaches, Pompano Beach Club and Coco Reef Resort. Advance reservations are required as venue changes nightly and space is limited.

La Serena Spa

La Serena means “serenity.” The spa offers Thai body-work and a range of other massages, award-winning Thalgo facials and body treatments, reflexology, Asian botanical treatments, CACI non-surgical face-lifts, herbal pedicures and manicures. Open daily from 9:00 AM to 6:30 PM (8:00 PM by appointment). La Serena’s direct line is (441) 239-0184.

Arrival & Departure

Check-in is 3:00 PM. Arrangements may be made to accommodate early arrivals. Check-out is at 12:00 PM (noon) with complimentary courtesy changing rooms available for late departures.

Transportation

Taxi service can be arranged for off-property activities. Taxis to and from the airport (about a 25-minute ride) generally cost about \$35 each way. Bermuda’s main form of transportation is the moped and rentals are available for guests. Bus service is also an option and the nearest stop is just steps from the property.
